The core of a conventional optical fiber is the part of the fiber that guides the light. They consist of three elements as shown in Figure 1: a central core, cladding and a protective coating. The core is surrounded by a medium with a lower index of refraction, typically a cladding of a different glass, or plastic. This component is foundational to high-speed internet, telecommunications networks, and. The core of a fiber optic cable is the thin glass or plastic center through which light signals travel.
