- o Aerial installation: Fiber is suspended on poles, requiring tension management to prevent sagging or breakage.
- o Direct-buried installation: Fiber is laid underground in protective conduits to prevent damage from digging or environmental factors.
- o Indoor installation: Fiber is routed through walls, ceilings, or cable trays, following fire safety and building



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codes .
