

# How many kilometers is a 4-core optical fiber cable

Fiber optic cable can be run anywhere from 300 meters up to 80 kilometers (roughly 50 miles) depending on the cable type, transceiver used, and network standard. For most enterprise or data center applications using multimode fiber, the practical limit sits between 300 m and 550 m. There are three main reasons for this: First, high-bandwidth signals are more susceptible to chromatic dispersion than. This characteristic is the primary reason multimode cables transport data over shorter distances (up to 2 kilometers for indoor use and 600 meters for outdoor use) than single-mode cables.
