

How many meters of galvanized cable tray

Standard galvanized cable trays are typically 3 meters long, with optional 6-meter lengths available.

Standard Lengths

Most manufacturers produce galvanized cable trays in standard straight lengths of 3 meters (3000 mm), which is suitable for most installations and simplifies transport and handling . For larger projects or longer runs, 6-meter (6000 mm) lengths can often be produced upon request, depending on the manufacturer and production method . These lengths apply to both pre-galvanized (PG) and hot-dip galvanized (HDG) trays, ensuring corrosion protection in various environments .

Variations by Duty Type

- o Light-duty trays: Typically available in 3-meter lengths, suitable for small cable runs and control wiring .
- o Medium-duty trays: Standard 3-meter lengths, with widths ranging from 50 mm to 600 mm, and optional 6-meter lengths for extended runs .
- o Heavy-duty trays: Standard 3-meter lengths, widths from 75 mm to 900 mm, with optional 6-meter lengths; designed for high cable loads and industrial applications .

Customization and Installation Considerations

Some manufacturers offer custom lengths beyond 6 meters if required for specific projects, though this may involve additional cost or lead time . When planning installation, consider support spacing, load capacity, and handling logistics, as longer trays may require additional support points to prevent sagging or deflection .
