

How to assemble a switch distribution box

- o Maintain proper spacing between live parts to prevent short circuits.
- o Ensure earthing and equipotential bonding for all metallic parts to protect against indirect contact .
- o Verify connections with a circuit tester before powering the board.

Step 6: Final Checks

- o Double-check all wiring against the diagram.
- o Ensure all breakers and switches are securely mounted.
