

# How to configure the wiring in a dual-power distribution box

A dual-power distribution box is wired to connect a primary and backup power source through contactors and relays, ensuring automatic switching and uninterrupted power supply.

## Overview

A dual-power distribution box, also known as a dual-power automatic transfer switch (ATS), is designed to maintain continuous power by switching between a main source (Source A) and a backup source (Source B) when outages occur . It is commonly used in industrial, commercial, and sensitive residential applications to protect equipment from downtime.

## Wiring Principles

### o Power Input Connections

- o Connect the primary power source to one air switch or input terminal.
- o Connect the backup power source to a separate air switch or input terminal.
- o Ensure that both sources are properly grounded and insulated .

### o Contactor Configuration

- o Use two AC contactors to manage the switching between the two power sources.
- o The primary source is typically connected to the non-delayed contactor, while the backup source is connected to the delayed contactor to prevent simultaneous connection .
- o Align the same phase of both sources to maintain phase synchronization and avoid short circuits.

### o Load Connections

- o Connect the output terminals of the contactors to the load circuits.
- o Ensure that neutral and ground wires are properly connected to the neutral bar and grounding terminal inside the distribution box .

### o Priority and Automatic Switching

- o Designate the priority source (usually the main utility supply).
- o The system automatically switches to the backup source if the primary fails and returns to the main source once it is restored .
- o Intermediate or time relays can be used to control the switching delay and prevent rapid toggling.

## Safety and Testing

- o Inspection: Before wiring, check insulation, conductivity, and grounding of all components .

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- o Simulation Test: Use a low-current test source (e.g., three-phase 5A) to simulate live operation and verify switching functionality .
- o Switch Testing: Test each source individually and in automatic mode to ensure proper contactor operation, phase alignment, and uninterrupted power delivery .
- o Precautions: Always turn off all power sources before starting installation and verify with a voltage tester. Follow explosion-proof or protective standards if applicable .

## Additional Considerations

- o Ensure the distribution box is compatible with the system voltage and current ratings.
- o Use proper protective devices such as MCBs, fuses, or surge protectors to safeguard equipment .
- o Maintain clear labeling of primary and backup circuits for easier maintenance and troubleshooting. By following these wiring principles and safety procedures, a dual-power distribution box can reliably provide uninterrupted power while protecting connected equipment from outages and electrical faults .
