Installing a fiber optic termination box is one of those jobs that looks simple on paper, but it's. The fiber termination box is an interface between the fiber cable from the line side and the pigtails to be passed to the fiber distribution frame. A fiber pigtail is a specific hardware connection used for cable termination. The distribution box can hold 6 cores termination and install 1×4 fiber optic splitter to distribute optical cable and split optical signal.

Termination of fibers: This process involves employing fiber-optic connectors, which interface with the adapters located in the termination box. Patch cords: Installation of patch cords by connecting fibers

Once you have your cores already routed you will splice with the 12 pigtails and connect them to the respective adapters. Then connect your indoor/ outdoor assembly (Jumper or Pigtail) to complete the

Fusion splicing involves melting the fiber ends together using an electric arc, while mechanical splicing uses alignment devices to connect the fibers.
