

How to connect fiber optic cable directly to a switch

- o **Optional Media Converter:** If connecting to a switch without fiber ports, plug the fiber into the media converter, then connect the converter's RJ45 port to the switch using a standard Ethernet cable .

Additional Considerations

- o **Connector Cleaning:** Always clean fiber connectors before insertion to prevent signal loss .
- o **Distance and Bandwidth:** Ensure the fiber cable length and type support the required network speed and distance .
- o **Direct Attach Cables (DACs):** For short distances, pre-terminated DACs with SFP+ modules on each end can simplify connections . By following these steps and using the correct SFP/SFP+ modules and fiber cables, you can establish a direct, high-speed fiber connection between your switch and network infrastructure.
