

# How to connect the 3-pin fiber optic panel socket

- o Use an optical power meter or OTDR (Optical Time-Domain Reflectometer) to verify signal strength and quality. Ideal GPON light levels range from -27 dBm to -8 dBm ( ).

- o Keep dust caps on any unused ports to prevent contamination ( ).

- o Always handle fibers with care; cut fibers are sharp and difficult to see ( ).

- o Avoid looking directly into live fiber connections, as infrared light can cause eye damage ( ).

- o Use ESD gloves and maintain a clean workspace to prevent static or dust contamination ( ).
