

How to connect the fiber optic cable to a Huawei router

Article Overview

You connect a fiber optic cable to a Huawei router via an Optical Network Terminal (ONT), using an Ethernet cable from the ONT to the router's WAN port, then configure the router with your ISP credentials.

Step 1: Prepare Your Equipment

- o Fiber optic cable: Usually a thin yellow cable with SC/APC or SC/UPC connectors .
- o Optical Network Terminal (ONT): Provided by your ISP; converts the fiber's light signal into an electrical signal your router can use .
- o Huawei router: Ensure it has a WAN port or supports fiber input via SFP/PON modules .
- o Ethernet cable: Cat6 or higher recommended for optimal speeds .

Step 2: Connect the Fiber Cable to the ONT

- o Locate the fiber wall outlet where your ISP's fiber line enters your home.
- o Remove protective caps from both the fiber cable and the ONT's optical port.
- o Align the connector carefully and insert it into the ONT's optical port until it clicks securely .
- o Power on the ONT and wait 2-5 minutes for the status lights to stabilize .

Step 3: Connect the ONT to the Huawei Router

- o Use an Ethernet cable to connect the ONT's LAN/Ethernet port to the WAN port on your Huawei router .
- o Power on the router and wait for the indicator lights to confirm a successful connection.

Step 4: Configure the Router

- o Connect a computer or mobile device to the router via Wi-Fi or Ethernet.
- o Open a web browser and enter the router's default IP address (check the label on the router) to access the admin panel .
- o Follow the setup wizard or manually enter your ISP credentials (username, password, VLAN settings if required) to establish the internet connection .
- o Optionally, update the router firmware to ensure optimal performance and security .

Step 5: Verify the Connection

- o Check the router's status lights and the ONT's PON/Optical light; solid green or blue indicates a successful connection .
- o Test internet access by connecting a device to the router and browsing online.

Tips

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- o Handle fiber connectors carefully; dirt or damage can degrade signal quality .
 - o Place the ONT and router in a dry, ventilated area near power outlets.
 - o If your Huawei router lacks a fiber port, a media converter may be required to bridge the ONT to the router .
- Following these steps ensures a stable fiber optic connection to your Huawei router, allowing you to fully utilize high-speed internet.
