



How to connect the set-top box s fiber optic cable

To connect your set-top box via fiber optic cable, plug the fiber cable into the Optical Network Terminal (ONT) and then link the ONT to your set-top box using the designated port or Ethernet connection.

Step 1: Gather Necessary Equipment

- o Fiber optic cable: Usually a thin, yellow cable with SC/APC or SC/UPC connectors .

Step 3: Link the ONT to the Set-Top Box

- o If your set-top box has a direct fiber input, connect the ONT's output to the box's fiber port.
- o If the set-top box uses Ethernet, connect an Ethernet cable from the ONT's LAN port to the set-top box's WAN or network port .
- o Power on the set-top box and wait for it to detect the network signal.

Step 4: Verify the Connection

- o Check the indicator lights on both the ONT and the set-top box to ensure a stable connection .
- o Test streaming or channel access to confirm proper signal transmission.

Tips for Optimal Performance

- o Keep the ONT close to the fiber entry point to minimize signal loss .
- o Avoid excessive bending or twisting of the fiber cable; maintain gentle curves.
- o Ensure firm seating of connectors; improper connections can reduce signal strength by over 30% .
- o For larger homes, consider mesh Wi-Fi or additional network devices if the set-top box relies on wireless
