

How to connect the static electricity wire to the distribution box

To connect a static electricity or grounding wire to a distribution box, attach it securely to the designated ground terminal or bus bar, following proper color coding and safety procedures.

Organize and Secure Wires Route the wire neatly within the box, avoiding sharp edges or tangling with other wires. Use cable ties if necessary, leaving space for heat dissipation . 7. Test the Connection After all connections are made, use a multimeter or insulation resistance tester to verify that the grounding wire is properly connected and has low resistance to the earth . This ensures effective static electricity discharge and safety. 8. Restore Power and Final Check Once verified, restore the main power and check that all circuits operate correctly. Ensure no sparks, unusual noises, or tripped breakers occur .
