

How to disconnect the splitter connector

You can connect a short patch cord directly from the wall "LINE" jack to the wall "VOICE" jack to remove all DSL equipment from the line (including the splitter). Trace the line to the first splitter, a metal unit that splits your wire off in various directions. Scenario: A company has two offices (A and B).

This is where a cable splitter comes into the picture. A cable splitter lets you take a single coaxial cable input, such as cable TV or satellite, and split it for connection to multiple rooms or pieces of gear.

So instead of messing around with audio-damaging splitters, connect whichever one of the DC1 outputs is unused to your headphone amp. In other words, use one DC1 output to drive your
