

How to expand the capacity of the distribution box

Distribution box capacity can be increased by using tandem breakers, installing subpanels, adding box extensions, or upgrading to larger or modular panels, depending on the system type and load requirements.

Residential Distribution Box Expansion

For homes, a full breaker panel can be expanded in several ways:

- o Tandem or half-size breakers: These allow two independent circuits to occupy a single slot, effectively increasing the number of circuits without replacing the panel. It is essential to verify that the panel is rated for tandem breakers to maintain safety and code compliance (Engineer Fix) .
- o Subpanels: Installing a secondary panel connected to the main panel via a double-pole breaker provides additional slots for new circuits while keeping the main panel protected. This is ideal when the number of circuits exceeds what tandem breakers can accommodate (Engineer Fix) .
- o Box extensions: Single gang or multi-gang box extensions increase the internal volume of the existing panel or junction box, allowing more wires or larger devices to be safely installed while maintaining NEC compliance (DIY Self) .
