

How to install cable tray fixing hangers

Article Overview

Cable tray hangers can be installed using wall brackets, ceiling suspensions, or center-hung supports, with proper spacing and secure fastening to ensure stability and code compliance.

Planning and Preparation

Before installation, plan the tray route and inspect the area for obstructions such as pipes or HVAC ducts. Mark the support points along the route using a chalk line or laser level, typically spaced 1.5 to 2 meters apart, depending on tray type and load capacity. Ensure you have the correct personal protective equipment (PPE), including gloves, safety glasses, and a hard hat, and gather tools such as a power drill, wrench set, measuring tape, level, hacksaw, and file for cutting and deburring trays .

Support Methods

o Wall Mounting (Cantilever Brackets)

- o Drill holes at marked points and insert wall anchors (expansion bolts for concrete).
- o Secure cantilever brackets to the wall, ensuring they are level.
- o Attach the tray to the brackets using bolts or hold-down clips .

o Ceiling Suspension (Trapeze or C-Hanger)

- o Drill holes into the structural ceiling slab and install drop-in anchors.
- o Screw in threaded rods and attach a horizontal Unistrut channel or trapeze hanger.
- o Level the strut and secure the tray sections on top using bolts or clips .

o Center-Hung Supports

- o Use threaded rods and a heavy horizontal bar to support trays from the ceiling.
- o This method is ideal for heavy power cables or multiple stacked trays, providing maximum stability .

Installation Steps

- o Measure and Cut: Cut trays to required lengths and deburr edges to prevent cable damage.
- o Place Trays: Lift tray sections onto supports.
- o Secure Trays: Fasten trays to brackets or struts with hold-down clips or bolts.
- o Join Sections: Use couplers or splice plates to connect tray sections end-to-end .

Safety and Compliance

- o Ensure supports can handle at least 25% more weight than the current cable load to prevent sagging or collapse .

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- o Follow NEC Article 392 or local electrical codes for cable fill, spacing, and grounding requirements .
- o Use corrosion-resistant finishes like hot-dip galvanized steel in wet or industrial environments .
- o Regularly inspect hangers for wear, rust, or loosening, and tighten or replace components as needed to maintain system integrity . By following these methods, cable tray hangers can be installed securely, ensuring safe, organized, and code-compliant cable management for commercial or industrial projects.
