

How to install fiber optic wall panels at home

- o Feed the cable into the panel: Run the incoming fiber through the entry port and coil any excess neatly inside the enclosure .
- o Terminate the fiber: Snap the pigtail connector into the socket adapter according to the manufacturer's instructions .

Step 4: Connect and Test

- o Attach the faceplate: Secure the panel's faceplate to the back box .
- o Connect to ONT: Use a patch cable (SC/APC to SC/APC) to link the wall panel to your ONT .
- o Measure light levels: Ensure the signal is within the recommended range (typically -8 dBm to -27 dBm for GPON networks) to confirm proper installation .

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Step 5: Safety and Maintenance

- o Wear safety glasses: Fiber optic cables carry invisible laser light that can damage eyes .
- o Avoid direct exposure to fiber ends: Never look directly into the cable or ONT laser.
