

How to install the cover of an indoor electrical distribution box

Safety First

- o Ensure the cover is made of non-combustible or fire-rated material, such as metal or fire-resistant plastic ().

- o **Mark Screw Locations:** Mark where the mounting screws will go to ensure precise alignment.
- o **Secure the Cover:** Insert screws into the mounting holes and tighten with a hand screwdriver. Avoid overtightening to prevent cracking plastic covers or stripping threads. The cover should be firmly held without bowing ().
- o **Check Accessibility:** The cover must be removable without damaging the wall, allowing future inspection or maintenance, in compliance with NEC requirements ().
- o **Test Functionality:** If the box contains switches or outlets, restore power and verify that the devices operate correctly and the cover does not obstruct them ().

Additional Tips

- o For aesthetic integration, consider hinged panels or decorative access doors that allow easy opening while concealing the box ().
- o Ensure clearance around the box for ventilation and safe operation, especially for larger distribution panels ().
- o Label circuits inside the box for easier maintenance and troubleshooting in the future (). By following these
