

How to make a pigtail look good when coiled to the side

- o Smooth flyaways with a light hairspray or hair serum for a sleek look .
- o Add decorative accessories like bows, clips, or ribbons to elevate the style and personalize it .
- o Gently tug at the braid or coil to create volume and softness, avoiding a too-tight or rigid appearance .

- o Side-coiled pigtails work well with bangs or face-framing layers to soften the overall look .
- o Experiment with asymmetry: one side higher or more voluminous than the other can create a chic, modern

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effect.

o For long hair, consider multiple small braids feeding into the coil for added texture and interest . By combining neat parting, secure coiling, optional braids or wraps, and finishing touches, your side-coiled pigtails can look polished, stylish, and versatile for any occasion.
