

How to peel back the wire in an optical cable

"Our solution is 'peelability,'" said Tim West. In your fiber optic cable assembly process, good stripping procedures are unquestionably essential. What happens if the fiber is damaged during the manufacturing process? A small nick or scratch in the optical fiber acts as a time bomb. Also known as optical fiber cable strippers, they hold cable within a slot, squeeze their jaws to press through the coating, and slide the coating off the end of the cable. Just pull the two strength membranes apart and gently peel the fibre away from whatever side its stuck to.
