

How to tie cable tray wires

Cable tray wires are connected by securely joining tray sections with splice plates, bolts, clamps, or quick-connect systems to ensure safety, stability, and easy maintenance.

Step 1: Prepare the Cable Tray Sections

Before connecting wires, ensure the cable tray sections are properly aligned and supported. Use wall-mounted cantilever brackets or ceiling trapeze hangers to hold the trays in place. Check that the trays are level and straight to prevent sagging or cable damage during installation .

- o Splice Plates (Flat Metal Plates with Holes): Bolt the plates to the ends of two tray sections to join them in a straight line. This method is strong, reliable, and works with most tray types, though it requires tools and time .
- o Bolted Connections: Use bolts, nuts, and washers to secure tray sections. This method allows for disassembly if future changes are needed and ensures a tight hold .
- o Quick-Connect Systems: Snap, slide, or twist systems from specific manufacturers allow fast installation with minimal tools. These are ideal for large projects where speed is important but may be brand-specific .
- o L, T, or Cross-Shaped Plates: Used for corners, junctions, or splits, allowing cables to route smoothly around bends without sharp angles .

Step 3: Secure the Connections

- o Align the tray ends carefully and place the splice plate or connector flat against the metal.
- o Tighten bolts using a wrench or torque wrench, ensuring the tray remains straight. Avoid over-tightening to allow minor adjustments during alignment .
- o Ensure the interior of the tray is smooth and free of gaps or sharp edges to prevent cable insulation damage .

Step 4: Install and Route the Cables

- o Lay the cables inside the tray, maintaining proper separation and fill ratios (typically max 50% of tray capacity) according to NEC or local codes .
- o Use hold-down clips or clamps to secure cables, preventing movement and reducing stress on connections.
- o For bends or junctions, use factory-made 90-degree bends or T-shaped fittings to guide cables smoothly .



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Step 5: Grounding and Safety

- o Ensure all metal trays are properly grounded to prevent electrical hazards.
- o Inspect all connections for tightness and alignment.
- o Verify that cables are not pinched or rubbing against sharp edges, which could cause insulation damage or short circuits . By following these steps, you can create a secure, stable, and maintainable cable tray system that safely supports electrical and data cables while allowing for future modifications.
