

How to turn off the power switch in a home electrical distribution box

This step is especially important if you are performing major electrical work. 5. Flip the Main Breaker: Firmly push the main breaker switch to the OFF position. This shuts off power to the entire house . You should hear a click as the breaker disengages. 6. Confirm Power is Off: Use a non-contact voltage tester at outlets, switches, or light fixtures to ensure electricity is completely off before starting any work . Never assume the power is off without testing.

Safety Precautions

- o Never touch exposed wires inside the panel; assume all wires are live until confirmed otherwise .
- o Avoid water near the panel; moisture increases the risk of electrical shock .
- o Do not force breakers that feel stuck; this could indicate a problem requiring a licensed electrician .
- o Have a flashlight ready in case the power goes out unexpectedly .
- o Call a professional if the panel shows signs of damage, burning, or corrosion .

Special Considerations

- o Older homes with fuse boxes: Pull the main disconnect or remove the main fuse block to cut power. Individual circuits can be turned off by unscrewing fuses counterclockwise .
- o Sub-panels: Some homes have sub-panels with their own main breaker, which only controls a subset of circuits. Turning off the sub-panel does not cut power to the entire house . Following these steps ensures that you can safely turn off your home's electrical power for repairs, maintenance, or emergencies while minimizing the risk of injury or electrical hazards.
