

How to use a fiber optic patch cord polishing tool

Article Overview

Using a fiber optic patch cord polishing machine involves careful preparation, precise adjustment of speed, pressure, and time, and sequential polishing with appropriate films to achieve a smooth connector end face.

Preparation

- o Gather Materials and Equipment: Ensure you have clean fiber optic connectors, the polishing machine, polishing pads or films, lapping films of various grit sizes (e.g., 30um -> 9um -> 3um -> 1um), isopropyl alcohol, lint-free wipes, and cleaning brushes .
- o Inspect Connectors: Check ferrules for scratches, dirt, or defects using a microscope (200X-400X) to ensure they are suitable for polishing .
- o Clean the Polishing Pad: Use high-purity isopropyl alcohol and lint-free wipes to clean the pad and remove any debris or contaminants .

Machine Setup

- o Install Polishing Pads or Films: Secure the polishing pad or film on the machine's platen. Ensure the film is centered and free of air bubbles, using DI water or alcohol to help remove trapped bubbles .
- o Adjust Machine Settings:
 - o Pressure: Move the four-corner pressure column to the required level (adjust while the machine is off) .
 - o Time: Set the timer for the required polishing duration .
 - o Speed: Start the machine, observe the speed display, adjust the speed control knob, and lock it once the desired speed is reached .
- o Prepare the Polishing Jig: Insert connectors into the jig, ensuring they protrude evenly and are perpendicular to the polishing surface .

Polishing Process

- o Coarse Polishing: Begin with the coarsest grit to remove major imperfections and shape the connector end face. Apply polish oil or water as needed .
- o Sequential Polishing: Progress through finer grits (e.g., 30um -> 9um -> 3um -> 1um) to achieve a smooth, high-quality finish .
- o Monitor Progress: Periodically check the connector end face to prevent over-polishing or scratches .
- o Emergency Stop: If needed, press the emergency stop switch. Reset by turning clockwise if the machine is stopped incorrectly .

Post-Polishing

- o Remove Connectors: Take the connectors out of the polishing jig and dry any remaining water or polish residue using an air gun .

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- o Inspect End Faces: Use a microscope to verify smoothness, absence of scratches, and correct angles (especially for APC connectors, which require an 8° angle) .
- o Record Data: Maintain polishing statistics for quality control and repeatability .

Precautions

- o Always adjust pressure, speed, and time before starting to avoid damaging the polishing film or connector .
- o Work in a clean, dust-free environment to prevent contamination .
- o Different connector types (SC, LC, FC, ST, APC, UPC) require specific polishing parameters .
- o Typically, 3-5 polishing cycles are recommended depending on connector type and finish requirements . By following these steps and best practices, you can achieve a high-quality, low-loss fiber optic patch cord suitable for reliable optical communication systems .
