

How to use a screw rod to lift cable trays

Install drop-in anchors and screw in threaded rods. Attach a Unistrut channel (or trapeze hanger) horizontally between two threaded rods to create a shelf for the tray. You will often need to cut trays to fit specific lengths or.
