To determine whether optical modules delivered for Huawei S switches before January 1, 2016 are certified ones, contact Huawei technical support. If your optical modules are delivered after

Use optical modules with a longer transmission distance on the two ports. When connecting switches through optical ports, pay attention to the following points:

If the optical module is delivered by Huawei in the early stage, the system is not affected. If not, the optical module may be abnormal, causing service interruption.
