

How to wire the socket in the distribution box

To wire a socket into a distribution box, connect the phase, neutral, and earth wires from the socket to the appropriate MCB and bus bars in the distribution box, ensuring proper protection and safety.

Step-by-Step Guide

1. Identify the Components in the Distribution Box

- o Main MCB: Receives the incoming power supply (phase and neutral).
 - o RCCB (Residual Current Circuit Breaker): Provides protection against earth leakage.

- o Use 2.5mm² wires for socket circuits.
 - o Strip the insulation carefully and ensure no exposed copper beyond the terminal .
- ### 4. Connect the Wires
- o Phase Wire (Live): Connect from the output terminal of the socket MCB to the phase terminal of the socket.
 - o Neutral Wire: Connect from the neutral bus bar to the neutral terminal of the socket.
 - o Earth Wire: Connect from the earth bus bar to the socket's earth terminal.
 - o If using a double-pole MCB, connect both phase and neutral from the RCCB output to the MCB input, then to the socket .
- ### 5. Wiring Direction and Organization

- o Route wires neatly: incoming wires on the left, outgoing wires on the right.
 - o Bind wires with plastic ties at uniform spacing to prevent tangling and ensure a clean layout .
- ### 6. Safety Checks

- o Verify all connections are tight and correctly placed.
 - o Ensure the socket circuit is protected by the MCB and RCCB.
 - o Perform a safety inspection to check for short circuits, overloads, or loose connections before switching on the power .
- ### 7. Testing

- o After wiring, turn on the main MCB and the socket MCB.
- o Use a socket tester or multimeter to confirm correct voltage, polarity, and earth continuity. By following these steps, you can safely wire a socket into a distribution box while ensuring proper protection and compliance with electrical safety standards.
