

# Installation of 50-Circuit Distribution Box

- o Circuit Wiring: Use the correct wire gauge for each circuit based on load requirements. Ensure neat cable management, proper insulation, and separation of neutral and ground wires.
- o Grounding: Properly ground the box and all metal components to prevent electric shock and equipment damage. Connect the neutral bar to the main panel as required by local codes .
- o Disconnect Switch: Install a disconnect switch between the main panel and the distribution box to allow safe power shutdown during maintenance .

Follow local electrical codes (NEC, IEC, or regional standards) and use UL/CE-certified components. Perform visual inspections and multimeter tests before powering on. Label all circuits clearly and consider modular designs for easier future upgrades .
