Step 1: Planning the Route

- o Standard support spacing is typically 1.5-3 meters, depending on tray type and load .

Step 5: Assemble and Align Trays

- o Connect trays using couplers or splice plates.

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- o Align trays straight and level, ensuring smooth transitions at bends, tees, or risers .
- o For long runs, use cable tray rollers to prevent kinks and damage during cable installation .

Step 6: Cutting and Deburring

- o Measure and cut trays to fit specific lengths or corners using a hacksaw or angle grinder .
- o Deburr all cut edges to prevent cable damage and ensure safety .

Step 7: Cable Installation and Grounding

- o Pull cables carefully through the tray, maintaining proper separation and fill ratios (usually max 50%), .
- o Bond and ground the tray system according to local electrical codes to prevent electrical hazards .

Step 8: Inspection and Documentation

- o Inspect all installed trays, supports, and grounding connections for compliance with approved designs .
- o Document and photograph the installation for quality assurance and future maintenance .
