

Installation of Belgian Cable Trays

Ladder-type trays allow airflow and easy cable entry, while perforated or solid-bottom trays are suitable for lighter loads or specific environments . Handle trays carefully to avoid coating damage, and use rollers for long cable runs to prevent kinks .

5. Cable Laying and Labeling

Identify each tray by feeder name and branch number. Lay cables according to spacing guidelines, ensuring proper separation and avoiding overcrowding. Install bonding jumpers and apply protective painting to cut ends if necessary . Tag and label trays for easy identification and future maintenance.

6. Inspection and Quality Verification

After installation, inspect all trays, supports, and accessories for alignment, level, and conformance with approved designs . An engineer or client representative should verify the installation, and all inspection results should be documented and photographed for records . Ensure grounding connections are properly installed and that the system meets safety and quality standards.
