Proper installation of ladder cable trays involves careful planning, material handling, site preparation, and adherence to international standards to ensure safety and durability.

Planning and Preparation

Before installation, review the approved shop drawings to determine the layout, length, and location of cable trays and ladders in the building . Ensure that all materials, including trays, ladders, and accessories, are available and verified for compliance with approved submittals. Any damaged or unsuitable materials should be removed from the site immediately . The installation area must be clean, free of debris, and safe for work, with scaffolding or working platforms arranged as needed .

Material Handling and Storage

Cable trays and ladders should be stored horizontally on flat surfaces with timber supports at intervals of about one meter to prevent bending or damage . Cover materials to protect them from moisture, sunlight, and dust, and ensure painted surfaces are stored indoors if possible . Accessories should be organized by type and width to prevent loss and facilitate installation .

Installation Guidelines

- o Support Systems: Ensure supports are strong enough to carry the weight of cables, future additions, and any imposed loads. Avoid cutting or drilling structural members without approval .
- o Mounting: Ladder trays should be mounted according to manufacturer recommendations and in compliance with standards such as BS EN 61537 for cable trays and BS 6946 for channel supports .
- o Alignment and Leveling: Check that trays are level and aligned, with deflection limits not exceeded. Use appropriate fasteners and fittings to secure trays to supports .
- o Cable Loading: Install cables carefully to avoid overloading the tray. Ladder trays are designed to support cables, not to be used as walkways or for personnel support .

Safety Considerations

Workers must be trained in working at height and follow HSE and JSEA requirements . Use scaffolding, lifting equipment, and personal protective equipment as required. Pre-start meetings should be conducted with site engineers, supervisors, and safety officers to ensure all personnel understand the installation plan and safety protocols .
