

Installation of Ladder-type Cable Tray Elbows

- o Position the Elbow: Place the ladder-type elbow at the designated location, ensuring it aligns with the straight tray sections and maintains the minimum bend radius for the largest cable .
- o Secure the Elbow: Attach the elbow to the straight tray sections using bolts, nuts, and washers. Provide additional support within 300 mm of the joint to prevent stress on the connection .
- o Maintain Alignment: Ensure the elbow is level and properly aligned with the tray system. Adjust supports as necessary to maintain horizontal or vertical runs .

Grounding and Finishing

- o Install Earth Continuity Strips: Connect grounding strips across all joints and fittings to maintain electrical continuity .
- o Protect Cut Edges: Remove burs and sharp edges, and apply approved galvanized paint to prevent rusting .
- o Verify Load-Bearing Cleats: For vertical runs, ensure cleats are installed to support the weight of the cables .

Final Checks

- o Inspect Installation: Confirm that all trays, elbows, and supports are securely fastened, level, and aligned according to specifications .
- o Compliance Verification: Ensure the installation meets relevant electrical codes and manufacturer guidelines .

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o Document Completion: Record inspections, approvals, and any deviations for QA/QC purposes .
