

Installation of expansion bolts for distribution boxes

Step-by-Step Installation

Final Checks Verify that the box is firmly mounted and level. Perform insulation resistance tests and check circuit continuity to ensure safe operation. Label circuits for future maintenance and troubleshooting . Tips:

- o For outdoor installations, use waterproof expansion bolts and a rain cover to prevent water ingress .
- o Avoid over-tightening screws to prevent deforming the box shell .
