- o Install circuit breakers or protective devices according to the electrical load requirements.
- o Route wires neatly inside the box, securing them with cable ties and leaving space for heat dissipation .
- o Ensure all connections are tight and properly sealed to prevent short circuits or overloads.

Step 5: Labeling and Organization

Label each circuit clearly to facilitate future maintenance and troubleshooting. Use modular designs or DIN rails if available to simplify upgrades and component replacement .

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Step 6: Testing and Acceptance

Before powering on, perform the following checks:

- o Visual inspection for loose connections or damaged components.
- o Insulation resistance test using a qualified tester to verify proper insulation .
- o Power-on test to check for abnormal sounds, voltage fluctuations, or faulty contacts .
- o Test all protective devices, including leakage protectors, to ensure correct operation.

- o Always cut off power before starting installation and verify with a tester .
- o Do not disassemble or modify the box without professional experience .
