- o **Distance and Signal Integrity:** Single-mode fiber can transmit data over tens of kilometers without significant loss, while multimode fiber is optimized for shorter distances but still outperforms copper.
- o **Symmetrical Speeds:** Fiber provides equal upload and download speeds, unlike cable internet, which often prioritizes downloads and limits uploads.
- o **Interference Immunity:** Fiber is immune to electromagnetic interference, maintaining consistent performance even in harsh environments.

Single-Mode vs Multimode Fiber

- o **Single-mode fiber:** Transmits a single light mode, ideal for long distances (up to 40 km) with high speed and minimal signal loss.
 - o **Multimode fiber:** Uses multiple light modes, suitable for shorter distances (up to 400 m) with high bandwidth but slightly higher attenuation.
