- o Hot-Dip Galvanization (HDG): Provides a robust zinc-iron alloy coating that protects steel trays for decades .
- o High-Resistance Alloys (ZnAl, ZnMg, ZnNi): Offer superior corrosion protection for wiremesh trays and fasteners, especially in industrial or coastal settings .
- o Powder Coating: Environmentally friendly and durable, suitable for both protection and aesthetics .
- o Anodizing (for aluminum trays): Creates a dense oxide layer that resists corrosion and UV exposure . In some cases, combining paint with galvanization or zinc-rich coatings can enhance protection, but careful maintenance and inspection are required to ensure effectiveness over time .

Applying anti-corrosion paint is acceptable for mild environments or where aesthetics are a priority, but for harsh or highly corrosive conditions, it is better to use galvanized, anodized, or alloyed trays. Regular
