The primary transmission and routing of data signals take place at the core layer only. The devices like high-capacity transmitters are placed in this. A core switch is a high-capacity, high-performance Layer 3 switch positioned at the physical backbone of an enterprise network. Engineered to aggregate massive volumes of data from distribution switches, it provides ultra-low latency and maximum throughput to ensure uninterrupted routing and packet. The layer that lies between the access layer and the core layer is known as the distribution or aggregation layer, while the backbone of the network is termed the core layer. Simply put, it's the kingpin that keeps your network humming. The access layer provides initial connections to end users.

Distribution Layer Switches: Positioned between the access and core layers, distribution switches aggregate traffic from multiple
