Overview of Optical Cable Terminals in Israel

Optical cable terminals in Israel, often referred to as cable landing stations (CLS), are facilities where submarine and terrestrial fiber optic cables terminate and connect to the national telecommunications network. These terminals are essential for high-speed internet, international data transmission, and cloud services. Israel's terminals are strategically located along the Mediterranean coast (e.g., Tel Aviv, Netanya, Ashkelon, Rishon LeZion) and the Red Sea (Eilat), enabling connections to Europe, Asia, and the Gulf region .

International Connectivity

One of the key submarine cables is the JONAH cable, a 2,300 km system connecting Tel Aviv to Bari, Italy, and extending into Europe via GTT's pan-European network. It features two fiber pairs capable of delivering 10G/40G/100G wavelengths with a total capacity exceeding 7 Tbps, operated by Bezeq International . Other international projects, such as the TEAS (Trans Europe Asia System), were planned to link Israel to Mumbai via Saudi Arabia and the UAE, although progress has been delayed due to geopolitical and logistical challenges .

Domestic Fiber Network Integration

Domestically, companies like Exelera operate advanced fiber networks connecting CLS to data centers (DCs) and border crossings with Jordan and Egypt. These networks provide ultra-low latency, high redundancy, and cross-border capabilities, supporting both business and cloud infrastructure needs . Israel is also expanding fiber optic coverage to households, aiming for 85% fiber penetration by 2025, ensuring that even remote areas can access high-speed internet .

Strategic Importance

Israeli optical cable terminals are pivotal for:

- o International data transit between Europe, Asia, and the Middle East.
- o Cloud and AI infrastructure, enabling server farms and data centers to operate efficiently.
- o Economic growth, by supporting digital services, telecommunications, and cross-border business operations.
- o National resilience, as domestic fiber networks provide redundancy and connectivity even during regional disruptions .
