The "all-dielectric" construction ensures electrical insulation, which is critical when deployed near high-voltage lines ranging from 110 kV to 500 kV . Their self-supporting nature allows them to withstand wind, ice, UV radiation, and other environmental loads without additional support .

## Structure and Types

ADSS cables are typically manufactured in two main structural designs:

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**Central Tube Structure:** Optical fibers are housed in a PBT tube with water-blocking material, wrapped with aramid yarn for tensile strength, and covered with a PE or anti-tracking outer sheath. This design is compact, cost-effective, and suitable for short to medium spans (50-150 meters) with low to medium fiber counts (12-48 cores), .

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**Layer-Stranded Structure:** Loose tubes containing fibers and water-blocking grease are twisted around a central reinforcement (usually FRP), with Kevlar yarn for added tensile strength and a PE or AT outer sheath. This design is optimized for longer spans and higher fiber counts, providing enhanced mechanical performance . Fiber counts in ADSS cables can range from 1F to 432F, available in unitube, loose tube, or ribbon configurations, depending on network requirements .
