## Overview of JDG Conduit

JDG conduit, also known as rigid galvanized conduit, is commonly used in industrial environments for its robust protection against physical damage, moisture, and stray currents. It is suitable for harsh conditions such as manufacturing plants, workshops, and metal processing machinery, and provides excellent grounding capabilities while allowing relatively easy installation and maintenance .

## Transitioning JDG Conduit to Cable Tray

When JDG conduit enters a cable tray, the following practices are recommended:

- o Bushed Conduit Entry: Conductors leaving the conduit can enter the cable tray through a bushed opening, which protects the wires from abrasion and prevents debris from entering the tray .
- o Flanged Connections: Alternatively, the conduit can terminate at a flanged opening on the tray or equipment, with the flange mounted directly to the tray. The opening should be sealed or covered to prevent debris ingress .
- o Securing Conductors: Conductors must be secured at the point of transition from the conduit to the tray to maintain mechanical stability and prevent strain on the cables .
- o Sealing: The outer end of the conduit or flanged opening should be sealed using approved methods, such as duct seal, to prevent dust or debris from entering the tray or equipment .

## Practical Installation Tips

- o Use appropriate fittings to connect JDG conduit to the tray, such as tees or custom junctions, which allow smooth routing and maintain system integrity .
- o Ensure bushings or grommets are installed at all conduit ends to protect conductors from sharp edges .
- o Maintain proper grounding by bonding the JDG conduit to the tray system if required, ensuring electrical safety in metal-rich environments .
- o Keep the transition short and direct, minimizing unsupported conductor lengths between the conduit and tray to reduce mechanical stress .

## Compliance Considerations

According to the 2020 NEC 392.46, conductors entering a tray or equipment from a raceway must be

protected, secured, and the opening sealed. Both bushed conduit and flanged openings are compliant methods, provided the conductors are properly supported and the entry point is sealed. This ensures both safety and adherence to code requirements. By following these guidelines, JDG conduit can be safely and effectively integrated with cable tray systems, providing mechanical protection, grounding, and compliance with electrical codes.
