

Junction box is not waterproof

Elevate and Protect the Box

Mount the junction box above ground or under a protective structure to avoid pooling water. Slightly tilt the box to allow drainage and prevent water accumulation .

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- o Desiccants: Place silica gel packs inside to absorb moisture and reduce condensation .
- o Breather vents: Use IP-rated vents to allow air exchange while blocking water entry .
- o Regular inspection: Check for cracks, warping, or seal degradation over time .

Always turn off power at the breaker before working on the junction box. Confirm circuits are de-energized with a voltage tester. Ensure proper grounding and GFCI protection if required .
