- o Breaker and Protection Integration: Outgoing circuits from the lower port are usually protected by breakers or fuses within the secondary distribution box, ensuring selectivity and safety for each branch .

- o Accessibility: The lower port is designed for easy access during installation and maintenance, allowing electricians to connect or disconnect circuits without interfering with the main bus or upper components.
- o Load Distribution: In larger buildings, multiple secondary panels may be fed from a main distribution board, with the lower port serving as the primary exit for localized loads, such as lighting, HVAC, or machinery .
- o Safety and Compliance: Proper labeling, grounding, and segregation of phases are critical at the lower port to prevent faults and ensure compliance with electrical codes .
