Key Functions

- o Overload Protection: It prevents excessive current from damaging wiring or appliances by tripping when the total load exceeds safe limits .
- o Fault Protection: In combination with residual current devices (RCDs) or RCBOs, it helps protect against earth leakage and short circuits .

Components Related to Main Circuit Control

- o Busbars: Metal strips that distribute incoming power from the main switch to individual circuit breakers .
- o Individual Circuit Breakers (MCBs): Protect each branch circuit by interrupting current flow in case of overload or short circuit .
- o Residual Current Devices (RCDs): Detect leakage currents and cut off power to prevent electric shocks .
- o Neutral and Earth Busbars: Provide safe connections for neutral and grounding wires, ensuring proper circuit operation and safety .

Types of Main Circuit Control Panels

- o Main Circuit Breaker Panel: Contains a single main breaker controlling all circuits, commonly used in commercial and industrial applications .
- o Main Lug Panel: Lacks a main breaker and relies on a breaker upstream for control, often used as a sub-panel .
- o Consumer Units: Residential panels with a main switch and multiple protective devices, sometimes including dual RCDs for cost-effective protection .
