- o Phase busbars, neutral bars, and earth bars
 - o DIN rail mounting for breakers and protective devices

Enclosure Protection and Material Choose a box with the appropriate IP rating: IP40 for general indoor use, IP54 for humid or splash-prone areas, and IP65 for fully waterproof outdoor installations . Materials should be durable and fire-resistant, such as cold-rolled steel ($\geq 1.2\text{mm}$) or flame-retardant ABS plastic . UV resistance and corrosion protection are important for outdoor or coastal installations.
5. Compliance with Standards Ensure the distribution box and devices comply with local and international standards, such as IEC 61439, IEC 60898, UL/NEC, or BS 7671 . Compliance ensures safety, reliability, and legal adherence.
6. Circuit Matching and Special Considerations
- o Room circuits: Separate circuits for each room to isolate faults
 - o High-power appliances: Dedicated circuits to prevent overload
 - o Lighting circuits: Separate from sockets to maintain illumination during faults
 - o Future upgrades: Reserve slots for EV chargers, solar inverters, or additional appliances

- o Mount the box at an accessible height with adequate clearance
 - o Connect phase, neutral, and earth conductors correctly
 - o Ensure proper grounding and bonding
 - o Only qualified electricians should perform live connections
