- o Multiple fiber/ribbon: Up to 24 fibers, often using MT or MPO connectors.

- o Push-pull or bayonet mechanisms for secure mating.
- o Connector body made of plastic or metal, designed to hold ferrule, boot, and coupling mechanism.

5. Performance Metrics

- o Insertion Loss (IL): Typically low, depending on ferrule polish and alignment.
- o Return Loss (RL): High for APC connectors, moderate for PC/UPC.
- o High-density suitability: MU connectors allow compact panel layouts without sacrificing performance.
