

Method for connecting cables to a distribution box

- o Connect the live wire to the main terminal or main circuit breaker (MCB).
- o Connect the neutral wire to the neutral bus bar.
- o Connect the ground wire to the grounding bus bar .

Installing Circuit Breakers and Sub-Circuits

- o Insert the circuit breakers into the designated slots on the DIN rail.
- o Connect each sub-circuit wire to its corresponding breaker, ensuring the wire is securely fastened.
- o Label each wire and breaker to indicate the circuit it controls for easier maintenance and troubleshooting.
- o Ensure that the total load does not exceed the distribution box's rated capacity .

Final Checks and Testing

- o Use a multimeter to verify that all connections are secure and there are no short circuits.
- o Check that all exposed wires are properly insulated.
- o Confirm that the grounding system is correctly connected.
