Overview of ENG Equipment

Electronystagmography (ENG) is a diagnostic tool used to evaluate balance disorders, vertigo, and cranial nerve function by recording involuntary eye movements (nystagmus) in response to various stimuli . ENG systems typically use electrodes placed around the eyes to detect electrical activity, while modern video-based systems (VNG) use infrared cameras integrated into goggles for precise eye tracking .
