Nepal is actively expanding its fiber optic network through highway, tunnel, and urban infrastructure projects to enhance national connectivity and digital services.

Project Overview

Nepal's fiber optic initiatives aim to strengthen the country's telecommunication backbone by laying optical fiber cables across highways, tunnels, and urban areas. Key projects include the Kathmandu-Terai Fast Track Highway, where Nepal Telecom has installed optical fiber along the 72.5 km route to provide the shortest and most efficient digital transmission path from the capital to the Terai region, improving both local and international internet traffic flow . Tunnel installations have also been completed, such as a 3 km 12-core optical fiber cable in mountainous tunnels, ensuring reliable communication in challenging terrain .

Key Players and Contractors

Several companies and licensees are involved in fiber optic deployment:

- o Nepal Telecom: Oversees major highway and backbone projects, including technical supervision and funding for installation .
- o Aarogya Construction Pvt. Ltd.: Specializes in underground optical fiber cable (UGOFC) projects, contributing to Ncell's network expansion with over 400 km of UGOFC and 100 km of overhead fiber completed, and nearly 1,500 km of UGOFC work through subsidiaries .
- o D-TECH Trading: Supplies high-quality 6-core and 12-core fiber optic cables for ISP, FTTH, CCTV, and telecom infrastructure projects across Nepal .

Installation Methods

Fiber optic cables in Nepal are installed using multiple methods depending on terrain and infrastructure:

- o Underground ducted and direct-buried cables for urban and highway routes.
- o Overhead cables using ADSS (All-Dielectric Self-Supporting) or OPGW (Optical Ground Wire) leased from Nepal Electricity Authority .
- o Tunnel installations with careful planning, cable pulling, splicing, and testing to ensure high-quality connectivity . Projects follow strict guidelines to avoid overlapping, maintain spacing between cables, and provide spare ducts for future expansion .

Regulatory Framework

Nepal Fiber Optic Cable Laying

The Nepal Telecommunications Authority (NTA) mandates that licensees obtain proper authorization before laying new optical cables. Sharing existing infrastructure is encouraged to reduce costs and prevent service disruption. Public notices are required when new routes are planned, and coordination among licensees is essential to minimize damage and ensure redundancy .
