

Opening an operating hole in the distribution box

Use a proper hole opener or step drill to create uniform, accurately aligned holes in a distribution box, avoiding welding or excessive force.

Step-by-Step Procedure

1. Plan and Mark the Hole Location Before drilling, determine the exact position of the hole based on the wiring layout and pipe arrangement. Use the manufacturer's knock-out holes if available. If additional holes are needed, mark the location 2 cm away from existing knock-out holes to maintain structural integrity and alignment . Ensure the holes are in a straight line and evenly spaced. Avoid creating long or irregular holes.

2. Choose the Right Tool

- o For metal or plastic enclosures, use a step drill or a hole opener. Step drills are safer for thin materials (up to 2-3 mm thick) and reduce the risk of material distortion .
- o Avoid using electric or gas welding to open holes, as this can damage the box and compromise safety .
- o If using a twist drill, secure the box and drill at a slow RPM to prevent the material from lifting or melting .

3. Drill the Hole

- o Drill at the marked points, keeping the drill perpendicular to the surface to ensure straight holes.
- o The hole diameter should match the size of the cable gland or expansion bolt to be used, allowing a snug fit without forcing the component .
- o For wall mounting, align the box's fixing holes with the drilled holes in the wall. Insert expansion bolts and fix the box slightly before final tightening .

4. Final Checks

- o Ensure the box is level and stable using a horizontal ruler.
- o Verify that the holes are clean, uniform, and free of burrs.
- o Confirm that the hole placement allows proper wiring, heat dissipation, and compliance with safety standards .

Safety Considerations

- o Always wear protective gloves and eye protection when drilling.
- o Ensure the box is de-energized before making any modifications.



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o Use waterproof or outdoor-rated boxes if installing in humid or outdoor environments .
