The bridge over the Tebicuary River is made up of a reinforced concrete structure. It is 1,175 m long and, 10.5 m wide, being the longest structure in the entire

The bridge is scheduled to be opened to traffic by the end of 2024. The project is being led by the consortium Construbase- Cidade- Paulitec. Three more partners are involved in the cross-border
