The Emboscada substation, a 500/220 kV facility, is Paraguay's largest and most strategic electrical distribution installation.

Overview

The Emboscada substation is a key component of Paraguay's electricity transmission and distribution network, designed to handle the country's highest electricity demand, particularly in the metropolitan and central regions, which together consume more than two-thirds of national electricity. This substation operates at 500/220 kilovolts, making it the largest in terms of voltage capacity and strategic importance.

Purpose and Impact

The substation is part of a broader modernization effort led by Paraguay's state-owned utility, Administracion Nacional de Electricidad (ANDE), to improve reliability, reduce outages, and enhance the efficiency of electricity delivery. It connects to the 220 kV network supplying the metropolitan area, ensuring stable power for households, businesses, and industries. Once operational, it is expected to benefit approximately 2.67 million residents, equivalent to around 764,000 families.

Technical Significance

- o Voltage Levels: 500 kV transmission input, stepped down to 220 kV for distribution.
- o Integration: Forms the backbone of Paraguay's national grid, linking major hydroelectric sources like Itaipu and Yacyreta to high-demand areas.
- o Modernization Features: Includes advanced metering, real-time monitoring, and secure power operation systems to reduce losses and improve service quality.

Strategic Role

The Emboscada substation is not only the largest in Paraguay but also a critical infrastructure project for the country's energy security. It supports the integration of renewable energy, strengthens the national grid, and enables Paraguay to meet growing electricity demand while maintaining high export capacity to neighboring countries.
