A fiber optic patch cord is a cable with connectors on both ends that links optical devices for data transmission in networks.

What is a Fiber Optic Patch Cord

A fiber optic patch cord, also called a fiber jumper, is a short optical cable with connectors at each end, designed to connect telecommunication or data networking equipment such as switches, patch panels, transceivers, and ONTs . It serves as a bridge for optical signals, enabling devices to communicate efficiently.

Construction

Patch cords consist of:

- o Core: High refractive index glass or plastic that carries light signals.
- o Cladding: Lower refractive index layer that reflects light back into the core.
- o Strength member: Aramid yarn (Kevlar) for durability.
- o Protective jacket: PVC, LSZH, OFNR, or OFNP depending on indoor/outdoor use .

Types of Fiber

- o Single-mode (SM): Yellow jacket, small core (~9 μm), suitable for long-distance transmission with low attenuation .
- o Multimode (MM): Larger core (50/62.5 μm), supports multiple light modes, ideal for short-distance, high-bandwidth applications. OM1/OM2 = orange, OM3 = aqua, OM4 = violet, OM5 = lime green .

Connector Types

Common connectors include LC, SC, FC, ST, MPO/MTP, MU, MT-RJ, E2000, DIN. LC connectors are small and high-density, preferred in modern data centers, while SC connectors are larger and easier to handle, often used in FTTH or CATV .

Simplex vs Duplex

- o Simplex: One fiber, one-way transmission.
- o Duplex: Two fibers, bidirectional transmission (Tx/Rx), commonly used in Ethernet and PON links .

- o Simplex or duplex configuration
